We are asking for an immediate response from Italian Foreign Ministry , that already received many other appeals, to activate with urgency all diplomatic measures to protect the right to live of Faith Aiworo, a young Nigerian woman.

Faith has been evicted from Italy in July to be repatriated in Nigeria, where she was immediately imprisoned and where she is sentenced to death because she resisted to rape.

The Italian Internal Ministry must responde of the big mistake of expulsion of this woman. Italian Government must plan a timely return to Italy of Faith, who Had already presented a request of asylum. Italian authorities have the duty – enshrined by the art. 19 of the Charter of the fundamental Rights of European Union, but also by the art. 2 and 10 of the Italian Constitucion - to give her the status of refugy or to provide her protection, Because there is the risk of sentence to death in Nigeria.

We confirm that the answer must be immediate, because Faith is wrongly in prison since last July, and since 2 years she is in Europe without documents because of injustice of European Laws about immigration.
